Resident/Student Poster Presentations

To encourage resident involvement and opportunities for networking with TNAAP members across the state, we are organizing a Resident Poster Presentation Session in conjunction with the annual Tennessee State Pediatric Conference. The juried poster session is planned for the evening prior to the conference and during breakfast the following morning before the conference begins. Poster presenters are encouraged to attend the conference the following day where winning posters will be announced.

Timeline:

- Submission deadline for abstract - July 30, 2019
- Notification of acceptance - August 15, 2019
- Presentation of poster – 8:45 – 10:00 PM, September 13 and 7:30 – 8:00, September 14, 2019
- Best poster announcements – Lunchtime on September 14, 2019

Eligibility:

Residents -- Pediatric or Med-Peds residents in a Tennessee program for the academic year 2019-2020 and senior Pediatric or Med-Peds residents in those programs who finish training in June 2019

Medical students – MD or DO students attending medical school in Tennessee during the academic year 2019-2020 and have an interest in the practice of Pediatrics

Topic categories are as follows:

- Research that has clinical applications and interest to practicing pediatricians
- Quality Improvement projects that have applications in pediatric practice environments
- Advocacy projects that directly relate to the well-being of children
- Patient case(s) reports that have applications to general pediatric practice

Awards: The abstracts will be peer reviewed for acceptance to the poster session by a committee of members representing the three sections of the state. ***The best posters will be announced at lunchtime during the Tennessee State Pediatric Conference on September 14, 2019.***

Format of abstract: Word limit 300. 12 point Arial font. Double spaced PDF file. Title, authors and institutions included. Suggested headings: Background/references, goal of project, methods/activities, data, conclusions/discussion. Submit abstracts to laurel.dorman@tnaap.org with subject line "Poster Abstract" no later than **July 30, 2019.**

Format of presentation: All accepted abstracts will be presented in a poster format. The poster size is 48 inches by 36 inches. The posters will be displayed on easels, so firm backing is required to clip or adhere the poster in position.
