Resident/Student Poster Presentations

To encourage resident involvement and opportunities for networking with TNAAP members across the state, we are organizing a Resident Poster Presentation Session in conjunction with the annual Tennessee State Pediatric Conference. The juried poster session is planned for an evening prior to the conference.

Timeline:

- Submission deadline for abstract - Thursday, July 15, 2021
- Notification of acceptance – No later than Monday, July 19, 2021 (notifications usually within one week of submission)
- Virtual Poster Presentations - 6 PM Central Time, Tuesday, August 3, 2021
- Winner Announcements will be given by August 6
- Winners will be Invited to Give Live Presentations - Saturday, August 28, 2021, Franklin, TN

Eligibility:

Pediatric or Medicine-Pediatric Residents/Chief Residents OR Medical Student during the academic year 2020-2021.

Topic categories are as follows:

- Patient case reports that have applications to general pediatric practice
- Quality Improvement Projects that have applications in pediatric practice environments
- Advocacy projects that directly relate to the well-being of children
- Research that has clinical applications and of interest to practicing pediatricians

Awards: The abstracts will be peer reviewed for acceptance to the poster session by a committee of TNAAP members representing the three sections of the state.

Format of abstract: Word limit 300. 12 point Arial font. Double spaced PDF file. Title, authors and institutions included. Photographs and charts are accepted to augment the body of the abstract. Suggested headings: Background/references, goal of project, methods/activities, data, conclusions/discussion. Submit abstracts to info@tnaap.org with subject line "Poster Abstract" no later than **July 15, 2021**.
